DID YOU KNOW...



OHP students often engage in patient care early in their programmes.

As you progress in the programme you will be exposed to more complex clinical care.

You may be expected to be involved in activities timetabled outside of normal working hours, e.g. emergency care.

REMEMBER

Students normally train in **simulated environments** to demonstrate **safety** before treating patients. Clinical activity is **supervised** and usually **progresses** from observation, assisting and finally operating.

Students will experience a range of healthcare settings and different population groups, eq: emergency departments, community clinics, vaccination centers.

You will be encouraged to take part in Oral Health promotion and prevention activities.



You will have to:

- Take accountability and responsibility for your study
- Blend manual skills with team work and interpersonal communication skills on a daily basis
- Be confident and safe in your clinical practice and know when to ask for assistance
- Be committed to lifelong learning when you graduate as a safe beginner
- Practice with professionalism and integrity at all times
- Be open to work in diverse environments including outreach and community activities
